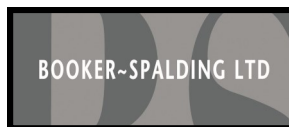
Petone Central School is guided by the values of:

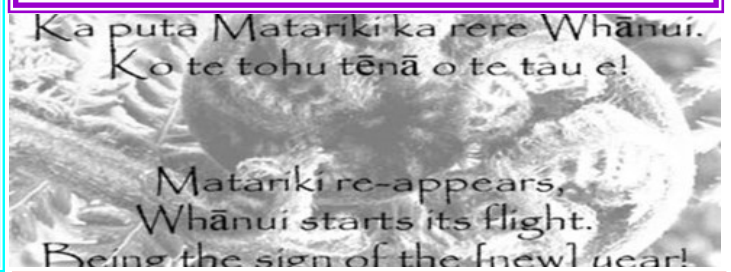
